Rekindling Our First Love *Revelation 2*:1 – 7

Introduction: Christians must maintain their love of Christ!

Context: 1:19 - 2:1

One: The Positives Regarding Lifestyle vs. 2, 3, 6

Two: The Negative Regarding the Heart vs. 4, 5 cf. Proverbs 4:23

Conclusion: Maintaining our testimony for Christ requires maintaining our love for Him and others. vs. 7
