A Plague of Judgment

Joel 1:1 - 20

Introduction: Calamity should drive us to our knees before God.

cf. Psalm 119:68

One: Calamity Itself vs. 1 – 4, 6, 7, 15

cf. 1 Peter 4:17

Two: Experience of Loss

vs. 5, 9a, 10 - 12, 16 - 18

cf. Deuteronomy 29:29

Three: Mourning

vs. 8, 9b, 13

cf. Hebrews 12:10; 1 Corinthians 10:12

Four: Calling on the Lord

vs. 14, 19, 20

cf. Psalm 139:23

Conclusion: God wants us to deal with calamity by processing it rightly in our relationship with Him.
