# Lifting our Enemies up in Prayer Matthew 5:43-48

1	1	( - 40 44)
L.	Jesus reframes the "law"	(vs. 43-44)

a. We love/pray for our neighbors AND our enemies

#### 2. We love/pray for our enemies because:

- a. It's following in our Father's footsteps (vs. 45)
- b. It's our testimony to the world (vs. 46-47)
- c. It's how we mature (vs. 48)

# **DIGGING DEEPER**

- 1. Can you think of any ways in which we add to/ take away from God's Word? (i.e. like the Israelites did with "hating their neighbor?") How might Jesus want to reframe our thinking about His Word?
- 2. How does our humanity (our struggle with anger, adrenaline, etc...) affect our witness at home, at school or at work?
- 3. Spend some time asking God to point out any people in your life (or who used to be in your life) who He wants you to start praying for.
- 4. Does viewing our spiritual maturity in connection with our willingness to obey God (even when we don't feel like it) make you feel encouraged or uncomfortable? Why?
