SERMON NOTES

Accept that All People are of Unsurpassable Worth to God Luke 7:36-50

1. Jesus accepts the invitation

(vs. 36)

a. All people really means ALL people

2. The Immoral Woman

(vs 37-38)

a. How does she see Jesus, Herself & Her sin

3. The Pharisee

(vs 39)

a. How does he see Jesus, Himself & His sin

4. The Lesson

(vs. 40-43)

a. It's not the amount of our sin, but the awareness of our sin that matters

5. The Gentle Teaching

(vs.44-48)

a. Seeing others through the eyes of Jesus

DIGGING DEEPER

1. /	Are there people in your life (or in the world)
you	find it difficult to love? What would God say
to y	ou about those people?

2. Think through the way you approach Jesus...do you align more with the immoral woman or with Simon the Pharisee?

3. If you were to make a list of your own sins... would they be "many" or "few?" Having a realistic view of our own sin not only gives us grace for others, but it increases our love for Christ.

4. Take some time this week to pray through who God might be asking you to invite to South Park Church...and then follow through on that invite. They are welcome here!
