SERMON NOTES

Jonah 1:4-1:16

1. The Storms (vs. 4)
 - a. Reveal what's in our hearts
 - b. Create opportunities to share our faith

2. Two very different experiences (vs. 5-6)
 - a. Sailors - working for the common good
 - b. Jonah - sound asleep

3. Jonah's identity revealed (vs. 7-10)
 - a. The clashing of multiple identities

4. Jonah's Sacrifice (vs. 11-16)
 - a. Jonah develops mercy

DIGGING DEEPER

1. Are you currently going through storms in your life? If so, as your reaction to the storm revealed anything about your own heart/faith?
2. Do you know of other people who are in the middle of their own storm? How could you come alongside them to support and love them?
3. When you reflect on the different ways Jonah and the sailors acted during the storm, who do you identify more with? And in what ways do you feel God calling you to wake up and work for the good of others “in the boat” with you?
4. Which parts of your identity clash the most with your identity as a child of God? What do you need to let go of...so that others can see God’s transformation in your thinking/life?
