Ignorance is Grief 1 Thessalonians 4:13 – 18

Introduction: Christ's return should be a great encouragement to believers. vs. 13

cf. John 14:1-3

One: Truths vs. 14-17 1. The Dead in Chirst vs. 14, 16 cf. Philippians 1:21-24 2. We Who are Alive vs. 15, 17

Two: Encouragement vs. 18

Conclusion: The guarantee of Christ's presence forever is the believer's blessed hope.
