11. What does a church filled with the Spirit look like? Refer to Acts 1-2. What sticks out?

12. Do you find yourself believing the early church had a power available to them through the Holy Spirit that simply isn't available to the church today? Why?

13. Have you GRIEVED the Holy Spirit recently? What do you need to do?
