The Glory of Christ - John 17:1-5

Introduction: Christians should seek to glorify Jesus Christ.

cf. John 16:33

Three Reasons to Glorify Jesus:

1: His Authority vs. 1-3

cf. Matt.28:18, 19

cf. John 14:6, 7

2: His Work vs. 4

cf. Gal. 6:14

3: His Eternal Status vs. 5

cf. John 1:14

Conclusion: We see that Jesus deserves all the glory of God!
