 The Two Greatest Commandments (Mark 12:28-31)
 --Love The Lord Your God With All Your Heart, Soul, Mind And Strength And Love Your Neighbor As Yourself

#### The Parable Of The Talents

- Matthew 25:14-30
  - A man about to go on a long journey entrusted varying amounts of his property to three servants
  - When he returned, he asked each to give an account
  - Two reported that they had doubled the value of the assets they had received while the other buried his and returned just the original amount

## The Parable Of The Talents

- Matthew 25:14-30--continued
  - To the two servants who had doubled the value of the assets they had received, the master said: "Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things.
    Come and share your master's happiness!"(25:21,23)
  - The master took the asset previously entrusted to him away from the third servant and he was thrown outside into the darkness where there is weeping and gnashing of teeth

## ECCLESIASTES: A ROADMAP FOR A WELL-LIVED LIFE

- Ecclesiastes addresses man's attempt to find meaning in God's creation without coming to know the Creator
- Romans 1:25---"They exchanged the truth of God for a lie and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator"
- Seeking and knowing God is the only true answer

- No.1A: <u>DON'T</u> Rely on Self-Fulfillment
- Eccl. 1:1-2:23
- Even a life like King Solomon lived does not satisfy--despite extreme power, wealth, wisdom,international acclaim, lavish possessions and extraordinary appetites for food,female companionship,etc.

- No. 1B : <u>DO</u> Enjoy Life as a Gift from God
- Eccl.2: 24-26
- God alone gives satisfaction and joy
- God also gives wisdom through His grace
- No one can live a fulfilled life apart from a personal relationship with God

- No. 2A: <u>DO</u> Recognize That God Has an All-Encompassing Plan
- God's plan embraces each of us in each season of our life (Eccl. 3:1-15)--Eccl. 3:1 "There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under Heaven."
- God's plan is perfect and all encompassing--Eccl. 3:2-8

## A TIME FOR EVERY SEASON OF LIFE

- $\circ~$  A time to be born and a time to die
- A time to plant and a time to reap
- A time to kill and a time to heal
- A time to tear down and a time to build
- A time to weep and a time to laugh
- A time to mourn and a time to dance

- A time to embrace and a time to refrain
- $\circ~$  A time to search and a time to give up
- A time to keep and a time to throw away
- A time to tear and a time to mend
- A time to be silent and a time to speak
- A time to love and a time to hate
- $\circ~$  A time for war and a time for peace

- No. 2B : <u>DON'T</u> Expect to Know All the Answers
- Eccl.8:17-- "Then I saw all that God had done.No one can comprehend what goes on under the sun. Despite all his efforts to search it out, man cannot discover its meaning. Even if a wise man claims he knows he cannot really comprehend it."
- Our need to know more should lead us to God

- No.3A : <u>DO</u> Focus on Enjoying Each Season of Life as God's Plan Unfolds (Eccl. 3:1-14)
- No.3B : <u>DON'T</u> Forget That We Are Accountable for What We Do (Eccl. 11:7-10)

- No.4A : <u>DO</u>Keep Our Focus On God (Eccl.3:1-15)
- No. 4B : <u>DON'T</u> Let the Difficulties (and Blessings) of Life Derail Us (Eccl. 5:17)

- No. 5A : <u>DO</u> Recognize and Give Thanks for God's Daily Multitude of Blessings (Eccl. 3:16 to 7:29)
- No.5B : <u>DON'T</u> Fail to Embrace Life's Challenges and Frustrations As Well (Eccl.3:16 to 7:29)
  - Be content and thankful in all circumstances
  - Some of God's greatest blessings come out of our greatest challenges

- No.6A : <u>DO</u> Remember That We Live in a Fallen World (Eccl. 9:1-6)
  - Sin and death are with us all
- No.6B.: <u>DON'T</u> Be Surprised That Many Human Experiences Seem Inconsistent With God's Plan (Eccl.3:16 to 4:16) --like death, injustice, oppression etc

- No.7A : <u>DO</u> Understand That Prosperity Is Not Always Or Necessarily Good (Eccl. 6:1-12)
  - If it takes our focus off of God
- No.7B : <u>DON'T</u> Mistake Adversity As Being Necessarily Evil (Eccl.7:1-15)
  - If it brings our focus back to God

- No.8A: <u>DO</u> Live Under Governmental Authority (Eccl.8:1-9)
- No. 8B: <u>DON'T</u> Expect the Government to Solve All Your Problems (Eccl.8:1-9)

- No.9A : <u>DO</u> Expect the Unexpected (Eccl. 9:12)
  - Be vigilant and prepared
- No. 9B : <u>DON'T</u> Be Paralyzed By Your Lack of Control Over Life (Eccl. 11:1-6)

No. 10A : <u>DO</u> Learn From All Experiences of Life (Eccl 3:16-7:19)

No. 10B : <u>DON'T</u> Wait Until You Are Old to Get the Right Perspective On Life (Eccl. 12:1-8)

- We must defeat our tendency to worship false gods
  - Work/success

  - Comfort
  - Security/safety
  - Money/possessions
  - Etc.,etc.,etc.
